#### Borth 350 Club

The 350 Club is a huge fundraiser and is vital to the continuation of our football club. For eight months during the playing season, three cash-prize winning tickets are drawn at random. Tickets cost £10, and all tickets will be used in each monthly draw. Committee members and players are expected to sell these to help raise money for the club.

Each player will receive five 350 Club tickets which **must** be sold - the money raised from these will cover your subs and fines for the season. There is also a prize of five tickets to the player who sells the most, so if you would like additional tickets then please ask any of the committee members for more!

If you have any concerns with selling Club 350 tickets then please discuss it with anyone on the committee - we are always here to help!

# **Player Registration**

Players will need to complete the relevant signing on form from the FAW website (J3 if they are not registered to a club, or J4 if transferring from another club): <a href="https://www.faw.cymru/en/about-faw/domestic/registration-forms">www.faw.cymru/en/about-faw/domestic/registration-forms</a>

Hard copies of the J3 form will be available from the club during pre-season. In addition to completing the above form, players will need to provide a mobile number to the club so that they can be contacted on short notice if required.

## **Training**

Pre-season training will mainly be held on each Thursday at 6:15pm in Borth, with fitness sessions on a Tuesday at Primal Fitness, 8:30 - 9:30pm (£4 for non-members, free for members). Winter training has already been organised at Park Avenue on a Wednesday, 7:30 - 8:30pm, at a cost of £2 a week per player.

From the start of this season we shall ask all players to confirm their availability for each training session in advance through the Club Chat before a deadline. This will ensure that both players and managers can fully benefit from as many of our training sessions as possible this season.

## **Match Day**

We shall ask players for their availability a few days in advance of games, with a deadline. This will enable us to organise our match day squads in advance and give all players involved as much notice as possible. Food will be served in The Railway after home games - we ask that you come along and help return their valued support by enjoying a beverage or two after a hard game's work!

#### **Fundraisers**

The club will hold fundraising events throughout the season, all players are expected to make an effort to attend and support Borth United. Fundraisers in the past have varied from horse racing evenings at The Railway to a golf day at Borth Golf Club. We are hoping to introduce a larger social element to the club this season, and tying it in with our fundraisers is a no brainer so keep an eye out for the next one!

## **Player Issues**

If you ever have any issues or concerns that you wish to raise then please discuss them one of the managers or even the Chairman, Mike. The committee are working hard to make Borth United better, with the aim of making it the best football club in the area. We are more than happy to discuss anything!
